Fire Inspector II Marcela Hammond is retiring from the Northwest Fire District on Wednesday, September 4, 2024. This date marks the conclusion of 5 years of dedicated service with NWFD and 25 years in the fire service.

Marcela began her career in 1999 as a Firefighter/EMT in the Phoenix valley. She worked for the City of Nogales for seventeen (17) years, with fourteen (14) of those years in active firefighting and emergency response roles. During her time at the City of Nogales, Marcela also held various positions including Public Information Officer, Public Educator, Fire Inspector, Fire Investigator, and Fire Marshal. Marcela joined the District on August 5, 2019, as a Fire Inspector I/Fire Investigator. On July 4, 2022, Marcela was promoted to her current role as a Fire Inspector II.

Marcela embodies NWFD's mission and values, generously sharing her extensive knowledge and experience both within the organization and the broader fire community. She has been an active member of the NWFD Peer Support Team since 2021 and currently serves as the District's Peer Support Coordinator.
