Captain Eddie Croy is retiring from the Northwest Fire District on Sunday, March 23, 2025. This date will mark the conclusion of over thirty-one (31) years of dedicated service to NWFD.

Eddie joined the District on January 15, 1994, as a part-time Reserve Firefighter and became a full-time Firefighter in April 1996. He was promoted to the rank of Engineer in January 2000. In December 2003, Eddie was promoted to the rank of Captain, a position he has held for the last twenty-one (21) years.

Eddie has received numerous awards during his tenure with the District, including Firefighter of the Year in 2000, four (4) Code Save Ribbons, a Congressional Commendation for Wildfire Service, and a Distinguished Service Medal. In 2024, he was honored with a Firefighter Commendation Ribbon for going above and beyond to assist a community member, and a Longevity Service Ribbon for his thirty (30) years of dedicated fire service.

Eddie has also received commendations for his leadership, service to the community, efforts as a Wildland Firefighter, and dedication to the training and professional development of others within the organization. His contributions have been invaluable to the success of Northwest Fire District and the fulfillment of the District's mission.
